

Sawnee EMC HVAC Rebate Consent for Load Management Switch

As described in the current Sawnee EMC <u>Energy Rebates and Incentives Program</u>, to receive SEMC's energy rebate for the installation of an outside condensing unit with a yellow ENERGY GUIDE rating of 17 SEER(or equivalent SEER 2) or higher, a member must grant permission for a **Load Management Switch** to be installed on the new unit. If for whatever reason the new unit cannot accept a switch, and there is not another HVAC unit at the residence to accept the switch instead, then SEMC shall pay the rebate.

By signing this form you grant permission for SEMC to install a Load Management Switch on your new HVAC unit, or another qualifying unit, at your residence.

The program runs June 1st to September 1st each year. On potential peak power usage days (typically the hottest days), the switch will be activated via a radio signal. This will enable the compressor on the HVAC unit to be cycled off for approximately 7 minutes out of every thirty. This generally occurs between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on approximately 20 days per year, but it can vary based on weather patterns.
