

Sawnee Electric Membership Youth Scholarship Criteria and Conditions

- 1. Student's residence must be served by Sawnee EMC.
- 2. Minimum GPA of 2.0.
- 3. Close relatives of Sawnee EMC employees, Sawnee EMC/Foundation Directors and CATF members are **not** eligible for this scholarship.
- 4. The recipient must be a high school senior.
- 5. Scholarships must be used at a two-year or four-year accredited institution.
- 6. Scholarship checks will be made payable to the post-secondary institution.
- 7. Scholarship finalists will be invited to and must attend a formal interview by a panel of judges who are retired educators.
- 8. The scholarship judges will consider scholastic achievement, character, leadership, volunteer service, career and life goals and any other information or circumstances that may heighten the need for this scholarship.
- 9. The scholarship recipients will be notified in April 2025.
- 10. The 2025 scholarship winners will be announced on the Sawnee EMC corporate website.
- 11. Applications, in full, must be received by 5:00 pm on Friday, January 9, 2026.
- 12. The applications are scored by independent judges.
